The Upliftment of Women Workers Mission

Help Promote Women Empowerment by Emphasizing the following :

- Her right to be recognized and protected
- To be provided with resources and economic opportunities, most specially those belonging to the “laylayan ng lipunan” or the marginalized
- Eliminating discrimination on the basis of a woman’s gender including becoming victims of sexual abuse, women trafficking or violence
- Provide support to other women, specially those involved in helping and caring for other women (i.e. NGOs)
- Introduce and educate women on government provisions such as privileges of women workers as spelled out by DOLE; rights and privileges of OFWs; or the solo parents act

Other Facets of a Woman That Must be Looked Into

- Health, both physical, emotional and mental;
- Rights as an Overseas Foreign Workers
- Spiritual life including inculcating Christian values in their families

(This theme is part of the declaration of the United Nations that the year 2020 represents an unmissable opportunity to mobilize global action to achieve gender equality)



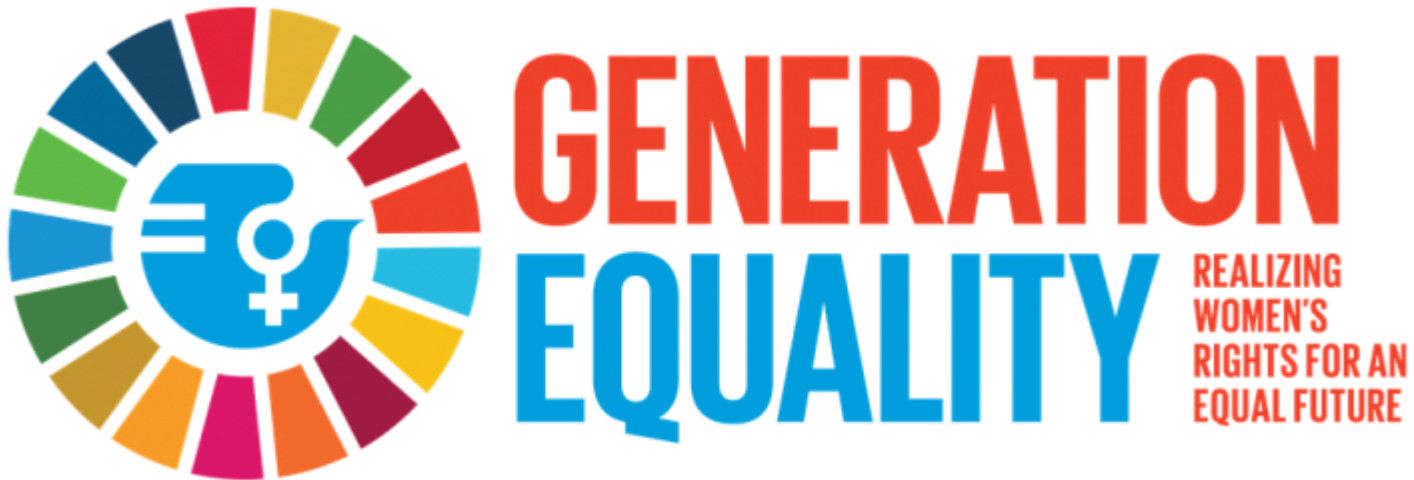
- Attend symposiums conducted by other women groups and share lessons with other sisters in the circle

- Financial Management

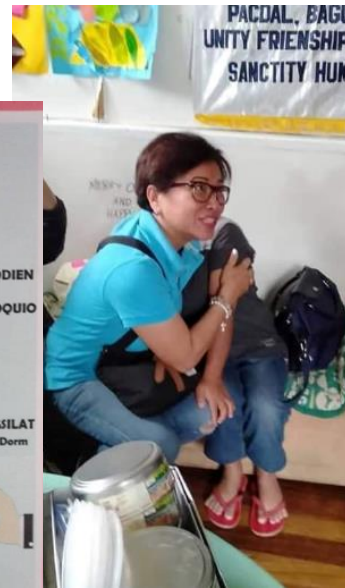
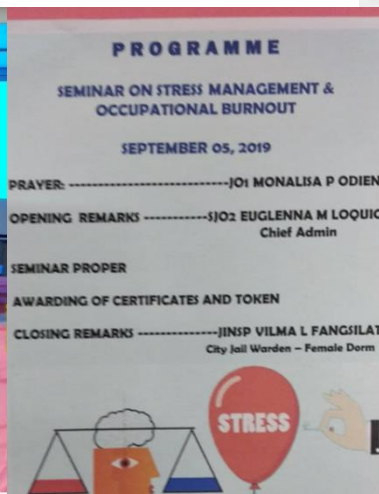
National Projects Per Quarter
